

MOORING YOUR BOAT AT ROYAL GOUROCK YACHT CLUB

Royal Gourock Yacht Club operates a launch service to take members and crew to and from their moored boats. At busy periods such as race events, two launches can be in operation.

Detailed below are the costs of keeping a 30 foot (9 metre) boat on a swinging mooring at RGYC from April to September and Winter storage at a boatyard. RGYC clubhouse has changing rooms, showers, a bar and restaurant with a first class chef.

FIRST YEAR

Initial cost of mooring incl laying	£1000
Crown estates levy	£ 60
Club membership fee	£ 360
Total	£1420 + Winter storage £450 = £1690.

Moorings are sometimes sold in situ by Members for around £500. These should be serviced before use.

SUBSEQUENT YEARS

Cost of servicing mooring	£150 (lift / clean / inspect / lay)
Crown estates levy	£ 60
Club membership fee	£ 360
Total	£570 + Winter storage £450 = £1020

Note that the above figures are “Ball Park”. Owners should make their own enquiries with a mooring contractor. See below.
